Feedback helps students of all abilities to achieve better results, and to improve the weaker students' achievements when realizing how to correct their understanding (Black & Wiliam, 1998:140) since these students might not have received the help needed in order to develop (Murphy, 1999:124). Christer Stensmo (1997) claims that feedback must be a part of teaching for the student to learn and develop (Stensmo, 1997:105). Alison Mackey (2006) presents research findings in second language acquisition which conclude that feedback develops second language learners since this is when they learn the language and are made aware of how the language is used (Mackey, 2006:1).
